- _____ Students applying to middle school **must** attach a copy of your 2007-2008 FIRST TRIMESTER REPORT CARD to your completed application. Out-of-district students must provide grades, attendance, and citizenship. (Does not apply to entering elementary students)
- _____ Mail each completed application and all accompanying information to the school(s) of your choice. Applications must be U.S. postmarked or hand delivered by **Monday, February 11, 2008 at 5 p.m.**, for consideration for enrollment in the 2008-2009 school year.

By signing below, I acknowledge my understanding of the following conditions for this application:

- Secondary school eligibility may be determined by such factors as academic performance, attendance, conduct, and on-site performance activities.
- When the number of qualified student applicants to a Select Schools program exceeds the number of seats available, a random selection process (lottery) will be utilized to accept qualified applicants.
- As part of the application process, preferences are made for geographic area, siblings, and feeder school alignment.
- Students who apply for and are accepted by more than one magnet school, may only accept one invitation.
- Students may only preregister at one ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PROGRAM.

- "Out-of-District" applicants must verify Clark County School District residency at time of enrollment to a Select School.
- This application is valid for the 2008-2009 school year.
- **If selected and registered, students are expected to remain in the program for the entire academic year.**
- Secondary Select Schools students who take less than a standard course load or drop from the Select School Program will become automatically ineligible for sports at the Select School for 180 school days. If a student chooses to return to his/her school of residence, he/she would be ineligible for the remainder of that school year and for 180 school days in any sport in which he/she appeared on an NIAA roster during his/her attendance at the Select School.
- If you have a disability that may affect your participation in the selected program area, you may voluntarily provide information about your disability by attaching it to the completed application.
